RUBBER AGGREGATE ROAD BUILDING GRANT

- Roads and Geotechnical Projects -

The Tire Stewardship Manitoba (TSM) Rubber Aggregate Road Building Grant provides up to \$20,000 in funding for the use of Tire Derived Aggregate (TDA) for approved projects delivered by Manitoba communities and non-profit organizations. The grant funding awarded, up to \$20,000, is to be applied toward the cost of TDA and installation for each approved Rubber Aggregate Road and Geotechnical Project. A scope of work demonstrating a minimum 100 metres of road or geotechnical project equivalent is required. Grant eligibility is subject to one grant per community organization per calendar year.

Project Funding

TSM will pay the Applicant a grant award for the total cost of all eligible expenses to a maximum amount of \$20,000 for the approved Rubber Aggregate Road or Geotechnical Project.

Who Can Apply?

Eligible Applicants

Manitoba communities that include municipal corporations, local governments, Northern Affairs and First Nations are eligible to submit project proposals. Individuals or groups excluded from the above list may submit a joint application with an eligible applicant.

Eligible Projects

To be eligible for funding, project proposals must:

- Demonstrates recycled tire aggregate benefits and is accessible to the public.
- Provide a project scope of work demonstrating a minimum 100 metres of road or geotechnical project equivalent; and a clear site plan highlighting the project area.
- Be environmentally and ecologically sound.
- Adhere to a realistic budget and timeframe with a distinct start and finish.
- Conduct project activities in Manitoba.

Funding Guidelines

- 1. Proposals will be reviewed for eligibility by the Tire Stewardship Manitoba Board of Directors who have final approval authority on project funding.
- 2. All applicants will be notified of decisions by email.
- 3. Successful grant recipients are required to sign a TSM Community Rubber Aggregate Grant Funding Agreement prior to project start date.
- 4. All funding requirements are to be met and the project is to be completed prior to the release of the approved funds.

Criteria

- 1. Funding is available for \$20,000.00 per Rubber Aggregate project.
- 2. Preference will be given to rubber aggregate made in Manitoba from Manitoba end-of-life tires.
- 3. The installation of the recycled tire product and site preparation must be done by professionals; volunteer labour will not be accepted.
- 4. Any project material purchased or work done prior to recipient receiving TSM project approval will not be eligible.
- 5. All permits and contracts of development are the responsibility of the applicant.
- 6. Approved applicants agree to provide access to Tire Stewardship Manitoba and its representatives to all financial records or other documentation related to the project.
- 7. The public must have access to the completed project.
- 8. Subject to one grant approval per community project, per calendar year.
- 9. Incomplete/illegible applications will not be accepted.

Submission Deadlines

Grant applications will be accepted throughout the year subject to funding availability. Applicants will be updated on the status of their proposal via email.
